




# Regional Support Manager Model

#### **Desire for Smaller Territories**

- Develop better relationships with all stakeholders in a state/region/territory
- Facilitate growth of EPs knowing coaches in a region
- Better understanding of the region/territory as a whole including special initiatives

## **Team Registration**



**Team Registration** 

\$200 per team - (US-Based) Eligible public/charter school and non-profit organizations may be eligible for a fee waiver


- Must be a "returning organization"
- Register and pay (marked "Paid in Full") for 6 teams
- Can apply for a waiver for the number of active teams above
   6 an organization had last year
- Ex. an organization had 10 "active teams" last season. If they pay for the first 6, they may be eligible for a fee waiver for 4 additional teams.



# **Team Registration**

#### (Continued)

- No team within an organization receiving a fee waiver may attend more than 2 Signature Events in the 24/25 season
- November 15th (fee waiver application deadline)
- December 13th (team registration deadline for 24/25 season)

- Generic or multi-user email addresses and names will no longer be accepted
  as valid entries in the Primary Coach and Secondary Coach fields. All email
  addresses listed in the account must belong to a single person.
- Any changes made to Primary Coach name or email information must be made by your Regional Support Manager. <u>All other changes</u> can be updated by the Primary Coach.

# **Background Checks - US Only**

Background checks will still be required for all Event Partners and will be valid for 2 competition seasons.

Coaches who are also Event Partners will only be required to complete one background check that will cover both roles. The Primary Coach will have the ability to see the current status of the Secondary Coach's background check.

Coaches and Event Partners must reapply for a background check every two seasons in June.

# Running Skills at Events

Work with Regional Support Managers (RSM) to identify VEX U Robotics Competition (VURC) teams in your region that may want to run skills at your event

- Robot Skills Scoresheets (signed by Scorekeeper Referee)
- Submit to RSM After Event

# **Accommodation Requests**

<u>Library Article for Coaches</u> <u>Library Article for EPs</u> Deadline to Submit Request

- Industry Certification testing:
   minimum of 2 weeks before the test
- ASL interpreter: minimum of 12
   weeks before the event
- Game/event: minimum of 4 weeksbefore the event

# **Accommodation Requests**

If approved, the Primary Coach must submit a copy of the approval letter to the Event Partner (EP) at least 2 weeks in advance of the event.

- The Primary Coach must also bring a copy of the letter to the event.
- RSM is not notified

# **Accommodation Requests**

- If the EP is, for any reason, unable to provide the necessary accommodation, the EP must notify the coach and the Regional Support Manager (RSM) in writing at least 1 week prior to the event to determine the best solution.
- If a verbal or written accommodation request that
  has not been formally approved is made at an
  event, or an approved request is brought to an
  event but was not communicated to the EP before
  the event, the EP is not responsible or obligated to
  accommodate the request.

# **Commitment to Event Excellence**

- Allow official sponsors/partners of the REC Foundation to set up a booth and/or display at any event.
- Give the REC Foundation access to event media (pictures, videos, etc) upon request.
- Follow all program specific branding guidelines.
- Use Participant Release Forms only for purposes specifically related to that event. Any misuse of information (including, but not limited to, non-REC Foundation related matters, sharing with other parties, private solicitation, etc.) may result in this access being revoked and/or removal of EP status with the REC Foundation.



- Remember that the teams, regardless of experience, have worked hard preparing for an event. Prioritize the team experience whenever possible and help students leave with great memories from their event. Volunteers and event staff should be kind and respectful to all students.

## **Qualifying Criteria**

The top 10 non-qualified teams on the World Skills Standings for HS V5RC, JROTC, and VURC will receive an invitation to VEX Worlds 2025.

An Event Region must have no more than 1 Event Region Championship.

Updated criteria for Blended vs Split Event Region Championships

Only allowance for a blended ERC is if **both** grade levels in a program have 1 spot

# **Qualifying Criteria**

Innovate Award is required at all qualifying events with judging

An Engineering Notebook and Judging Interview is required to win any judged award at a qualifying event.

Exceptions: Judges Award, Sportsmanship Award, Inspire Award, Energy Award

Multi-Day Event Region Championships - Encourage now, required in 25/26

Each Signature Event must be single grade level only.

VEX Robotics World Championship spot allocation (coming August 2024): An Event Region will be allocated no more than 16 spots for V5RC and 18 spots for VIQRC.

#### **Field Tech Certification**

#### Raspberry Pi's

- 2's no longer supported with new TM
  - No troubleshooting options for these
  - Pi 2's should be replaced
- With new update, SD cards need to be reimaged
- Raspberry Pi 5's now fully supported

#### **EP Discounts**

- 4 V5RC game element discounts 50%
- 4 V5RC perimeter 50%
- Trophy Pack same as last year (1 per program/grade level per EP)

#### **Refund Policy**




