- ☐ Is the drone you are using an unmodified CoDrone EDU, CoDrone EDU JROTC Edition, or Parrot Mambo? (see rule 2.1.1)
- ☐ If any motors, propellers, or the frame were replaced, were they replaced only with identical parts from the original manufacturer? (see rule 2.1.2)
- ☐ Is your drone running the most up-to-date firmware recommended by the manufacturer? This is only applicable to the CoDrone EDU and CoDrone EDU JROTC Edition. (see rule 2.1.1)
- ☐ Do you understand that your drone may only be flown in a designated flight or testing area? (see rule 2.4.2)
- ☐ Will you complete a pre-flight checklist for both the drone and controller before every match? (see rule 2.4.1)
- ☐ Do you understand that you must wait for the referee's "all clear" before entering the flight zone to retrieve your drone after a match? (see rule 5.2.1)
- ☐ Will all flight team members wear eye protection during every match? (see rule 2.4.3)
- ☐ Do you understand that if a referee identifies an immediate safety issue, you must ground your drone immediately? (see rule 2.4.4)
- ☐ Do you know how to use the emergency stop feature on the CoDrone EDU or CoDrone EDU JROTC Edition and understand that the emergency stop should only be used during an emergency or when there is a safety concern, and that under normal conditions you should land the drone using the land command?
