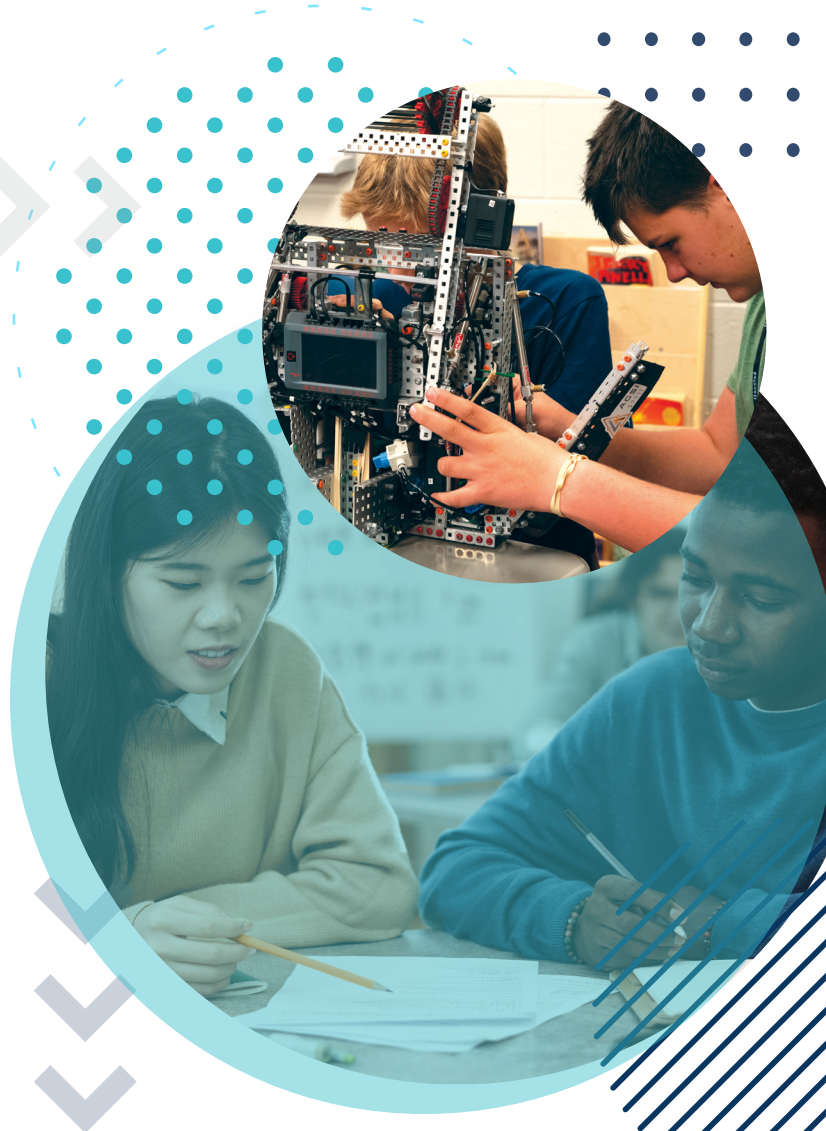




Earn graduation honors in competitive robotics
